### Northern living quarters

The northern living quarters consist of a series of interconnected rooms. The walls are decorated with wooden panelling, used from the 15<sup>th</sup> century onwards for insulation.

### Southern living quarters

In the 15<sup>th</sup> century, the southern living quarters were reserved for the Tierstein residence. They are flanked by wooden galleries and lead to the trophy room and armoury. In this room, a collection of bladed weapons dating from the end of the Middle Ages is exhibited as well as armoury linked to the castle's history.
